

This is the last Will and Testament of me Robert Marshall of Edenbridge in the county of Kent Gentlemen first I do hereby order and direct all of my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to be fully paid and discharged

I do hereby give and bequeath to my three daughters Anne Pontifex Sarah Pontifex and Mary Pontifex all monies which may be payable to my executors in respect of a policy of insurance that has been affected on my life in the Norwich Union Insurance Company and in case any or either of my daughters shall die previous to my decease then I direct that the share of such as may so die shall go and be divided equally amongst the child or children of such as may so die such child or children to take the same share as his her or their mother would have been entitled to if she had lived

I give devise and bequeath all my real estate of whatsoever kind or nature soever and also all and every the rest residue and remainder of my personal Estate of all kinds and descriptions to my son Henry Marshall of Godalming Surrey and John Pontifex of Saint Andrews Court Holborne upon trust that they said Henry Marshall and John Pontifex do immediately make sale and dispose of the same for the best price they may be able to procure and stand possessed of the product thereof upon further trust to divide the same equally between all and every of my sons and daughters who shall be living at the time of my decease and the child or children of of such of my said sons and daughters who shall have died the child or children of those who may have died to take only the share that his her or their parent would have been entitled to

I hereby request that my trustees be paid all the expenses of --- this my Will into execution and do give them every power as far as I can which may enable them to do so and I do further appoint them the executors thereof and do hereby revoke and make void all former and other wills by me at any time heretofore made and do --- those present only to be and contain my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I the said Robert Marshall the testator have --- to this my Will contained in one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of March eighteen thirty

I Robert Marshall of Edenbridge in the county of Kent do hereby declare the following to be a codicil to my last Will and Testament which bears date and was signed sealed published and declared by me as such on the fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty

first I hereby give and devise to my son Henry Marshall of Godalming in the county of Surrey Solicitor and to his heirs and assigns forever all my messuage tenement and premises with the appurtenants there to belonging situated and being at Godalming aforesaid in the county of Surrey and called the mead Row --- being opposite the Three Lions hotel

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary the wife of John Pontifex all my Goods furniture linen china and other things belonging to me and being at or appurtenant to any house in Edenbridge aforesaid except plate which direct maybe divided by said daughter Mary at her discretion equally as near as may be amongst her own children and the children of my son in law Edmond Pontifex and my son in law William Pontifex

Next I direct that my executors should pay a years rent for my said house in Edenbridge after my decease I also request and desire that my executors bury me at Edenbridge aforesaid in a manner similar to the burial of poor John Alexander and that the funeral be conducted by Mr Chandler

I give and bequeath to the poor of the parish of Edenbridge ten pounds to be distributed amongst them by the church wardens as they may see fit in bread

I also give and --- to my trustees and executors the sum of fifty pounds cash in all other respects I do hereby ratify and confirm my last Will and Testament in witness thereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighth day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight in the presence of the witnesses hereunder subscribed
